What is HTML?

- HTML stands for **HyperText Markup Language**.
 - It is used to **structure web content** by defining elements like headings, paragraphs, lists, links, images, and more.
 - HTML is **not a programming language** but a markup language that tells the browser how to display content.

HTML History

- **HTML 2.0 (1995)**: First standardized version with basic page structure.
- **HTML 3.2 & 4.01**: Introduced tables, styles, and scripting support.
- **XHTML (2000)**: Combined HTML with XML rules.
- **HTML5 (2014)**: Modern standard with multimedia support, semantic tags, and APIs.
- Shows the **evolution and increasing capabilities** of HTML over time.
